

1. Cover Page should contain Name, Semester, Paper code, Name of the Course/paper, Class Roll Number, **University Roll No, University Registration Number, Year of registration**, Contact Number, E-mail id.
2. The maximum word limit for each course is **1000 words**.
3. The write ups must be **hand written**.
4. Each paper **MUST** contain margins in all sides.
5. The write ups **MUST** be clean and legible.
6. There should be **ABSOLUTELY NO** decoration or painting in the cover page.
7. **DATES & TIMING OF** Assignment submission **must be strictly followed**. No request will be entertained if any student fails to submit the assignment on the given scheduled date and time.
8. Assignment of absent students will be considered only when their parents will submit the medical certificate in the Department.
9. Assignments to be submitted in the respective class, not in the Department.
10. Students must have to be in the proper UNIFORM. Otherwise, assignment will not be accepted.
11. No stick file is needed for assignment submission.
12. Students are directed to write assignment on two topics.


