This memorandum is executed on this 29th day of January, 2022 at Silchar, Assam between Department of Sanskrit and Philosophy, Gurucharan College, Silchar as the First Party and Sanskrit Bharati, Purvottar Bharat, Silchar as the Second Party.

Gurucharan College has its campus at College Road, Silchar established in 1935. It has been maintaining its reputation as a centre for Quality education in higher education in Arts, Science and Commerce streams. It is affiliated to the Assam University and registered under 2(F) and 12(B) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956. It was accredited by NAAC during 2016 and graded as A. The college also achieved the status of College with Potential for Excellence from UGC in the same year.

The Department of Sanskrit, Gurucharan College established in 1935. Prof. Shishir kar Sastri was the Founder Head of this department. Educational Development is the main goal of the Department. Side by side we also take interest in their Character building. We also try our level based for all-round development of the students. Gurucharan College has a long heritage of imparting Sanskrit education as the Sanskrit Department was started since the very inception of the college. Many eminent scholars like Late Shishir Kar Shastri, Prof. Kamini Adhikari, Prof. Prof. Kshitish Paul Choudhury, Prof. Sita Nath Dey, Prof. Swapna Devi, Prof. Shanti Pokhrel and others glorified the Department by their able guidance and teachings.

To promote Sanskrit language through various programmes like lecture programme, Sanskrit speaking course and Certificate Course for Development of innovative ideas and teaching methods of Sanskrit.

3. CERTIFICATE COURSE/LECTURE PROGAMMES ON SRI BHAGAVADGITA


Both the department Philosophy, Department of Sanskrit and Sanskrit Bharati will take initiative for organize Certificate course on Bhagavad Gita and Lecture progamme on Bhagavad Gita for develop purposeful life, a fulfilling carrier, meaningful relationships, and true inner spiritual happiness and a practical manual to live a transformed life of goodness and greatness.

ARBITRATION:


Except in noting the provisions of this MoU, no use of the name, symbols, sign of one institution shall be used by other. This agreement shall become effective from the date of its signing and continue thearafter for five years subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement and unless terminated by either of the two parties hereto. Termination by one institution shall be effected by giving the other institution at least (90) days advance written notices of its termination. Either party may request in writing a revision, variation or amendment of this Memorendum of Understanding. Any such revision, variation of amendment agreed by parties shall be in writing and shall form part of this Memorendum of Understanding. Such revision, variation of amendment shall come into force on such date as may be determined by

the parties. Both the departments of the institutions and organization agree to the above terms and conditions in principle subject to the completion of such other formalities required by the rules governing both the institutions.
